

# 2008 RACE COMMITTEE PROCEDURE

## EUGENE YACHT CLUB - TRITON YACHT CLUB JOINT RACE COMMITTEE

---

<b>5:30</b>	Arrive at caretakers trailer	Checkout:	Briefcase 2 hand held radios 2 boat keys 2 rescue satchels
	Meet with crew	Put crew members names on finish sheet. ( <i>Important</i> ) Assign crew members duties Verify boat handling competence <b>Everyone should bring their own lifejacket</b> <b>(the PFDs provided are intended for use in a rescue)</b> It is recommended life jackets be worn at all times	
	Before leaving dock	From the shed: Make radio contact with “ EYC “ and “ Rescue Boat “	Pick up flag set for Committee Boat Pick up large green buoy for Rescue Boat
<b>6:00</b>	Leave the dock	Tie up to center pin:	Choose course and display on course board Set start line ( approx. 15 keelboats per start so length should be a min. of 300’ ) No paper work at this time

**6:20 Start digital recorder playback and record the time (hrs:min:sec)**

**6:25 #1 FLAG UP; 1 SOUND** (Per “Starting Sequence” Sheet)

**FOLLOW “STARTING SEQUENCE” SHEET UNTILL ALL CHASSES HAVE STARTED**

### After all starts:

If Center Finish course is run, Committee Boat remains on station to record finishes

If a Tower course is run, Committee Boat

Pick up green buoy
Proceed to tower / Set finish line
Put boat away
Set up in tower to finish boats

Rescue Boat	Monitors race from a center of course position with particular attention to the Portsmouth fleet. Confirms with R.C. that all boats are finished or accounted for. Pick up green buoy. Put boat away.
