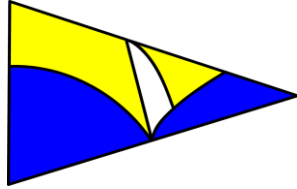


“Live on the Edge” Pennant Rules

1. The “Live on the Edge” Pennant:



is awarded to the most consistent overall sailor (entry) in the Regatta, with the fleet size taken in consideration.

2. Pennant Points are based on sailors' individual race results, not on the final ranking in his/her fleet. Throw outs are not allowed in the Pennant Point calculation.
3. The RPS formula used for the Pennant Points is as follows:

Sum of ((individual race scores)²) / sqrt of the fleet size)

This formula rewards consistent high scoring and rewards a similar result in a large fleet over that in a small fleet.

4. The sailor (entry) with lowest total points will win the “Live on the Edge” Pennant. This is a perpetual trophy. The winner will receive free regatta entry for the following year's “Live on the Edge” Regatta to defend the Pennant.
