
## "Live on the Edge" Pennant Rules

1. The "Live on the Edge" Pennant:



is awarded to the most consistent overall sailor (entry) in the Regatta, with the fleet size taken in consideration.

- 2. Pennant Points are based on sailors' individual race results, not on the final ranking in his/her fleet. Throw outs are not allowed in the Pennant Point calculation.
- 3. The RPS formula used for the Pennant Points is as follows:

Sum of ((individual race scores)^2) / sqrt of the fleet size)

This formula rewards consistent high scoring and rewards a similar result in a large fleet over that in a small fleet.

4. The sailor (entry) with lowest total points will win the "Live on the Edge" Pennant. This is a perpetual trophy. The winner will receive free regatta entry for the following year's "Live on the Edge" Regatta to defend the Pennant.
